AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PRO-  
2 GRAM'S DIVISION OF TEACHERS; REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC  
3 SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM'S DIVISION OF TEACHERS FOR FISCAL  
4 YEAR 2025; APPROPRIATING PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND MONEYS FOR TRANSFER  
5 TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; CLARIFYING THE ORIGINAL FUND  
6 SOURCE FOR EXPENDITURES FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PRO-  
7 GRAM'S DIVISION OF TEACHERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REDUCING THE APPRO-  
8 PRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM'S DIVISION  
9 OF TEACHERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; CLARIFYING THE ORIGINAL FUND SOURCE  
10 FOR EXPENDITURES FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM'S  
11 DIVISION OF TEACHERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY  
12 AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.

14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

15 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
16 the appropriation made to the Public Schools Educational Support Program's  
17 Division of Teachers is hereby reduced by \$42,527,100 from the Public School  
18 Income Fund for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

19 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Con-  
20 troller shall transfer \$42,527,100 from the Public School Income Fund to the  
21 General Fund on July 1, 2024, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the pe-  
22 riod July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

23 SECTION 3. Of the amounts reduced in Section 1 of this act for the Pub-  
24 lic School Support Program's Division of Teachers, \$42,527,100 shall be re-  
25 duced from the amounts considered expended from the General Fund for the pe-  
26 riod July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

27 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
28 the appropriation made to the Public Schools Educational Support Program's  
29 Division of Teachers in Section 1, Chapter 276, Laws of 2023, is hereby re-  
30 duced by \$36,093,700 from the Public School Income Fund for the period July  
31 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024.

32 SECTION 5. Of the amounts reduced in Section 4 of this act for the Pub-  
33 lic School Support Program's Division of Teachers, \$36,093,700 shall be re-  
34 duced from the amounts considered expended from the General Fund for the pe-  
35 riod July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024.

36 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
37 declared to exist, Sections 4 and 5 of this act shall be in full force and ef-

1     fect on and after passage and approval, and Sections 1 through 3 of this act  
2     shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
