1 AN ACT  
 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; APPRO-  
 3 PRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR  
 4 FISCAL YEAR 2025; AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-  
 5 TIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REQUIRING A REPORT ON SUICIDE PREVENTION;  
 6 PROVIDING A LIMITATION FOR STANDARDS REVIEW AND ADOPTION PROGRAMS;  
 7 PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR THE CAREER READY STUDENTS  
 8 PROGRAM; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF  
 9 EDUCATION FOR THE STUDENT SERVICES PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; AND  
 10 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

12 SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law,  
 13 there is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Education the fol-  
 14 lowing amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and  
 15 expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through  
 16 June 30, 2025:

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SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided to the State Department of Education is hereby increased by two and five tenths (2.50) for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

SECTION 3. SUICIDE PREVENTION. The State Department of Education shall provide a report on the utilization and implementation of funds appropriated for suicide prevention in schools. The report shall be submitted to the Legislative Services Office Budget and Policy Analysis Division no later than December 1, 2024.

SECTION 4. STANDARDS REVIEW AND ADOPTION PROGRAMS. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 49-308, Idaho Code, and any other provision of law to the contrary, of the amounts appropriated in Section 1 of this act and any other appropriation provided by law from the Driver Training Fund, no more than \$150,000 shall be used for standards review and adoption programs.

1 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated  
2 to the State Department of Education any unexpended balances appropriated  
3 to the State Department of Education from the Career Ready Students Fund  
4 for fiscal year 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$39,000,000 from the Career  
5 Ready Students Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to the  
6 Career Ready Students Program for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30,  
7 2025. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation  
8 amount by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services  
9 Office Budget and Policy Analysis Division prior to processing the reappro-  
10 priation authorized herein.

11 SECTION 6. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-  
12 ter 189, Laws of 2023, and any other appropriation provided by law, there  
13 is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Education for the Student  
14 Services Program \$2,000,000 from the Federal Grant Fund to be expended for  
15 trustee and benefit payments for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30,  
16 2024.

17 SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, Section 6 of this act shall be in full force and effect on  
19 and after passage and approval, and Sections 1 through 5 of this act shall be  
20 in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
