## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

LEGISLATURE AND PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF JOINT 2 RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 3 OF THE STATE OF IDAHO. 4

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 5

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate recognize and re-6 spect the significant time and effort expended by the opposite chamber in 7 8 drafting, refining, researching, considering, debating, and voting on various pieces of legislation; and 9

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate deem it necessary 10 and desirable to amend Joint Rule 3 of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the 11 House of Representatives to create an atmosphere of honor in the Idaho Legis-12 13 lature.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives 15 and the Senate concurring therein, that the Joint Rule 3 of the Senate and the 16 17 House of Representatives shall be amended to read as follows:

# JOINT RULE 3

19 Report of Action Taken and Transmittal of Bills, Joint and Concurrent Resolutions and Memorials. -- (a) When final action shall have been taken on 20 any bill, joint or concurrent resolution or memorial in the house in which it 21 originates, it shall be transmitted to the other house on or before the first 22 order of business of the receiving house on the next succeeding legislative 23 day with an endorsement thereon by the Secretary or Chief Clerk, as the case 24 may be, showing a complete record of all action taken thereon. When final ac-25 tion shall have been taken on any bill, joint or concurrent resolution which 26 has been passed in one house, it shall be returned to the house in which it 27 28 originated on or before the First Order of Business of the receiving house on the next succeeding legislative day with an endorsement thereon by the Sec-29 30 retary or Chief Clerk, as the case may be, showing a complete record of all action taken thereon. 31

Hearing Guaranteed on Certain Actions Passed in Other House. -- (b) A 32 bill or joint resolution passed by one house with a floor vote of two-thirds 33 majority or greater shall be guaranteed a hearing in an applicable germane 34 35 committee in the other house within ten legislative days.
