A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF
IDAHO, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 8, ARTICLE VI, REGARDING ONE
ROUND OF VOTING AND PERSONS WITH THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES BEING
DEEMED ELECTED; STATING THE QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE;
DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO PREPARE THE STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY
LAW; AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PUBLISH THE AMENDMENT AND
ARGUMENTS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

9 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Idaho, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 8, Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Idaho and to read as follows:

Section 8. ONE ROUND OF VOTING - PERSON WITH THE HIGHEST NUM BER OF VOTES ELECTED. In any election, there shall be one round of
 voting, and the person having the highest number of votes for an of fice shall be deemed to have won such election.

18 SECTION 2. The question to be submitted to the electors of the State of19 Idaho at the next general election shall be as follows:

"Shall Article VI of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended by the addition of a new Section 8, to provide that there shall be one round of voting and the person having the highest number of votes for an office shall be the winner of an election?"

24 SECTION 3. The Legislative Council is directed to prepare the state-25 ments required by Section 67-453, Idaho Code, and file the same.

26 SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to publish this 27 proposed constitutional amendment and arguments as required by law.
