SENATE BILL NO. 1223

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE PROCUREMENT ACT; AMENDING SECTION 67-9208, IDAHO CODE,  
TO REVISE A PROVISION REGARDING NOTICE OF A SOLICITATION; AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 67-9208, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
amended to read as follows:

67-9208. SOLICITATIONS. (1) The administrator shall not make or  
cause to be made any acquisition until a requisition for the property to  
be acquired has been submitted to the administrator's office by the req-  
uisitioning agency. The requisition shall certify to the administrator's  
satisfaction that there are sufficient funds or balance in appropriations  
out of which the amount of the requisition may be lawfully paid, except as  
provided in section 67-9221(3), Idaho Code.

(2) Upon determining that an agency's requisition complies with the  
provisions of subsection (1) of this section, the administrator shall issue  
a solicitation. Notice of the solicitation shall be posted in a conspic-  
uous manner as prescribed by rule. The notice shall describe the property  
to be acquired in sufficient detail to apprise a vendor of the ~~exact nature~~  
specifications or required outcomes of the property being sought and shall  
~~set forth the bid closing date, and time and location.~~

(3) The administrator may establish by rule exceptions to the notice  
provisions in subsection (2) of this section; provided however, that the  
procurements excepted from the notice provisions must be minor in nature.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
July 1, 2024.
