CODE REFERENCE; AMENDING SECTION 44-2008, IDAHO CODE, TO REMOVE A CODE
REFERENCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section <u>44-2012</u>, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 repealed.

9 SECTION 2. That Section 44-2007, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 10 amended to read as follows:

44-2007. PENALTIES. Any person who directly or indirectly violates any provision of this chapter, excluding the provisions of sections 44-2012 and 44-2013, Idaho Code, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisonment for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

17 SECTION 3. That Section 44-2008, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 18 amended to read as follows:

19 44-2008. CIVIL REMEDIES. Any employee injured as a result of any violation or threatened violation of the provisions of this chapter, excluding 20 the provisions of sections 44-2012 and 44-2013, Idaho Code, shall be enti-21 tled to injunctive relief against any and all violators or persons threat-22 ening violations and may in addition thereto recover any and all damages, 23 including costs and reasonable attorney's fees, of any character resulting 24 from such violation or threatened violation. Such remedies shall be inde-25 pendent of and in addition to the penalties and remedies prescribed in other 26 provisions of this chapter. 27

28 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
29 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
30 passage and approval.
