AN ACT

- RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES; AMENDING SECTION 22-1904, IDAHO CODE, TO RE-2 VISE A DEFINITION; AMENDING CHAPTER 19, TITLE 22, IDAHO CODE, BY THE 3 ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 22-1905A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE REQUIREMENTS 4 FOR LAUNCH AND TRANSPORT OF CONVEYANCES; AMENDING SECTION 22-1911, 5 IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF ANNUAL REVENUE DEPOSITED IN THE 6 INVASIVE SPECIES FUND MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE TO COUNTIES, CITIES, AND 7 OTHER LOCAL ENTITIES FOR CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES; AND DECLARING 8 AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9
- 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. That Section 22-1904, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 22-1904. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise noted in this chapter the def 14 initions as set forth in section 22-2005, Idaho Code, are adopted by refer 15 ence.

(1) "Conveyance" means a terrestrial or aquatic vehicle or a vehicle
part that may carry or contain an invasive species or plant pest. A conveyance includes a motor vehicle, a vessel, a motorboat, a sailboat, a personal watercraft, a trailer or any other means or method of transportation.
"Conveyance" also includes a live well or a bilge area of a watercraft, retail or wholesale products, or water known to carry or have a reasonable possibility of carrying invasive species.

(2) "Environmental harm" means to cause significant adverse effects onuses of natural resources or on plants or animals.

(3) "Invasive species" means species not native to Idaho, including
 their seeds, eggs, spores, larvae or other biological material capable of
 propagation, that cause economic or environmental harm and are capable of
 spreading in the state. "Invasive species" does not include crops, improved
 forage grasses, domestic livestock, or other beneficial nonnative organ isms.

31 SECTION 2. That Chapter 19, Title 22, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 32 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-33 ignated as Section 22-1905A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

34 22-1905A. REQUIREMENTS FOR LAUNCH AND TRANSPORT OF CONVEYANCES. (1) 35 Immediately upon removing a conveyance from any waters of this state or 36 for transport of conveyances within the state, the operator shall remove 37 all visible vegetation from the conveyance and drain all water from the 38 conveyance, including but not limited to water in the hull, ballast tanks, 39 bilges, live wells, and motors. All bilge and ballast plugs and other barri1 ers that prevent water drainage from a conveyance shall be removed and remain 2 open while a watercraft is transported by land within the state.

3 (2) Before launching a conveyance in Idaho, a nonresident vessel owner
4 shall purchase an invasive species sticker pursuant to section 67-7008A,
5 Idaho Code. Further, nonresident conveyances shall be inspected at a water6 craft inspection station prior to launch.

7 SECTION 3. That Section 22-1911, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 amended to read as follows:

9 22-1911. INVASIVE SPECIES FUND. There is hereby established in the10 state treasury an invasive species fund.

(1) The fund shall receive such appropriations as deemed necessary by 11 12 the governor and the legislature to accomplish the goals of this chapter. The fund shall also receive moneys from the collection of reasonable fees for 13 permits or as otherwise required by this chapter or rules promulgated here-14 under. The fund may also receive, at the discretion of the director, mon-15 eys from any other lawful source including, without limitation, fees, penal-16 ties, fines, gifts, grants, legacies of money, property, securities or other 17 assets, or any other source, public or private. 18

(2) Moneys in the invasive species fund are subject to appropriation
for the purposes of this chapter. The fund shall be used to support activities related to the prevention, detection, control and management of invasive species in Idaho.

(3) All interest or other income accruing from moneys deposited to the
fund shall be redeposited and accrue to the fund. Any unexpended balance
left in the fund at the end of any fiscal year shall carry forward without reduction to the following fiscal year.

(4) Up to twenty percent (20%) of the annual revenue deposited in the in vasive species fund pursuant to section 67-7008A, Idaho Code, may be made
 available by the department to counties, cities, or other local entities for
 the cost of equipment and supplies necessary for the operation of watercraft
 inspection stations. Such funds shall be for equipment and supplies only and
 not for labor.

33 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 34 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 35 July 1, 2024.
