RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE IDAHO COMMISSION FOR LIBRARIES; AP-2 PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE IDAHO COMMISSION FOR LIBRARIES FOR FISCAL 3 YEAR 2025; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT PO-4 5 SITIONS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR LIBRARY PROJECTS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR DIGITAL ACCESS CAPACITY; 6 REAFFIRMING STATUTORY COMPLIANCE REGARDING TELEHEALTH FACILITIES; 7 PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND 8 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Idaho Commission for Libraries the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Idaho Commission for Libraries is authorized no more than thirty-five and five-tenths (35.50) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

33 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR LIBRARY PROJECTS. There is 34 hereby reappropriated to the Idaho Commission for Libraries any unexpended 35 and unencumbered balances appropriated or reappropriated to the Idaho Com-36 mission for Libraries from the ARPA Capital Projects Fund for fiscal year 37 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000 from the ARPA Capital Projects Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to library capital
projects for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. The Office
of the State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation amount by fund,
expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services Office Budget and
Policy Analysis Division prior to processing the reappropriation authorized
herein.

7 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR DIGITAL ACCESS CAPACITY. There is hereby reappropriated to the Idaho Commission for Libraries any 8 unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated to the Idaho Commission 9 10 for Libraries from the Federal Grant Fund for fiscal year 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$1,750,000 from the Federal Grant Fund, to be used for nonre-11 curring expenditures related to digital access capacity for the period July 12 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. The Office of the State Controller shall 13 confirm the reappropriation amount by fund, expense class, and program, with 14 15 the Legislative Services Office Budget and Policy Analysis Division prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein. 16

SECTION 5. TELEHEALTH FACILITIES. Of the moneys reappropriated in Section 3 of this act from the ARPA Capital Projects Fund for library facilities projects, no funds shall be expended for facility and technology projects that do not comply with Sections 18-608 and 18-617, Idaho Code.

SECTION 6. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in 21 statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may 22 be used only for that purpose. Funds provided in this act are subject to 23 accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section 24 67-702, Idaho Code, provided the Legislative Services Office auditor has 25 sufficient resources to conduct those reports. State agencies that are 26 27 authorized to contract for outside audits shall submit those reports to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee when those reports become avail-28 able. 29

30 SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 31 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 32 July 1, 2024.
