### SENATE BILL NO. 1338

#### BY RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

#### AN ACT

- RELATING TO IRRIGATION DISTRICTS; AMENDING SECTION 43-109, IDAHO CODE, TO
  PROVIDE FOR THE MODIFICATION OF BOUNDARIES OF DIVISIONS OF IRRIGATION
  DISTRICTS AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMER GENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 43-109, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 amended to read as follows:

43-109. DIVISIONS OF DISTRICT FOR ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. (1) Such 9 board shall also make an order dividing the district into not less than three 10 (3) nor more than seven (7) divisions of as nearly equal size as practicable, 11 12 which shall be numbered first, second, third, etc., and one (1) director, who shall be an elector and resident in the division, shall be elected from each 13 division of the district at large, except that in districts of three thousand 14 (3,000) acres or less the directors may be elected from qualified electors, 15 holding title or evidence of title to land in the district and residing in 16 the county in which some portion of the district is located. The number of 17 divisions into which said district shall be divided shall be specified in the 18 petition for the organization of the district, and if not otherwise speci-19 20 fied shall be three (3).

21 (2) The board of directors of the district may, after approval of a res-22 olution by two-thirds (2/3) of the board, petition the board of county com-23 missioners to modify the boundaries of divisions of the district previously ordered by the board of the county commissioners. The petition shall pro-24 vide a reason for modifying the division boundaries and a map showing the new 25 proposed boundaries. The divisions shall be of as nearly equal size as pos-26 sible. No bond or examination by the department of water resources shall be 27 required. The board of county commissioners shall hold a hearing on the pe-28 tition pursuant to the procedures of section 43-106, Idaho Code. The board 29 of county commissioners shall make an order revising the division boundaries 30 31 as requested by the petition, unless the board of county commissioners finds there is good cause to deny the petition or to modify the division boundaries 32 33 in a different way.

34 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 35 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 36 July 1, 2024.
