6 7	SECTION 1. That Section 18-4007, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Manslaughter is punishable as follows: Voluntary by a fine of not more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), or by a sentence to the custody of the state board of correction not exceeding fifteen (15) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Involuntary by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or by a sentence to the custody of the state board of correction not exceeding ten (10) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Vehicular in the operation of a motor vehicle: For a violation of section 18-4006(3) (a), Idaho Code, by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or by a sentence to the custody of the state board of correction not exceeding ten (10) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. For a violation of section 18-4006(3) (b), Idaho Coder: For a violation of section 18-4006(3) (b), Idaho Coder: For a person who has not previously been found guilty of or pled guilty to a violation of the provisions of section 18-8004 or 18-8006, Idaho Code, or any substantially conforming foreign criminal violation, as described in section 18-8005(10), Idaho Coder, by a fine of not more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), or by a sentence to the custody of the state board of correction not exceeding fifteen (15) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. (ii) For a person who has previously been found guilty of or pled guilty to a violation of the provisions of section 18-8004 or 18-8006, Idaho Code, or any substantially conforming foreign criminal violation, as described in section 18-8004 or 18-8006, Idaho Code, or any substantially conforming foreign and imprisonment. (d) In addition to the foregoing, any person convicted of a violation 1 2 of section 18-4006(3), Idaho Code, which that resulted in the death of the parent or parents of minor children may be ordered by the court to 3 pay support for each such minor child until the child reaches the age of 4 5 eighteen (18) years. In setting the amount of support, the court shall consider all relevant factors. The nonpayment of such support shall 6 7 be subject to enforcement and collection by the surviving parent or quardian of the child in the same manner that other child support orders 8 are enforced as provided by law. In no event shall the child support 9 judgment or order imposed by the court under this section be paid or in-10 demnified by the proceeds of any liability insurance policy. 11

(e) In addition to the foregoing, the driver's license of any person
 convicted of a violation of section 18-4006(3), Idaho Code, may be suspended for a time determined by the court.

15 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 16 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 17 July 1, 2024.
