- RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE; APPRO-2 PRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR 3 FISCAL YEAR 2025; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY; DIRECTING USE 4 5 OF FUNDS FOR VOTER PAMPHLETS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 6
- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 7

8 SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, 9 there is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes 10 from the General Fund for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025: 11

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated 17 to the Office of the Secretary of State any unexpended and unencumbered bal-18 ance appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State for election in-19 tegrity audits and elections system upgrades for fiscal year 2024 for the pe-20 riod July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. The Office of the State Controller 21 22 shall confirm the reappropriation amounts, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappro-23 priation authorized herein. 24

SECTION 3. VOTER PAMPHLET COSTS. Of the amount appropriated in Sec-25 tion 1 of this act or any other act for the Office of the Secretary of State, 26 \$350,000 from the General Fund shall be used solely for the production and 27 dissemination of the voter pamphlet. Any remaining unexpended and unencum-28 bered amounts not so used shall revert to the General Fund. 29

30 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 31 32 July 1, 2024.
