This appropriation to the Hispanic Affairs Commission provides an enhancement to the FY 2025 maintenance budget to include the additional 2% CEC.

FISCAL NOTE

This appropriation provides an additional \$4,300 to the maintenance appropriation provided to the Commission on Hispanic Affairs found in Senate Bill 1270. Table 1 shows incremental adjustments to the budget found in the bill, of which the ongoing increase is \$4,300 and there are no onetime appropriations. Table 2 shows the adjustments leading to the FY 2025 Total. The total budget for the Commission on Hispanic Affairs is \$507,600.
