AN ACT 1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; 2 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL 3 QUALITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DE-4 PARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; AUTHORIZING 5 ADDITIONAL FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIA-6 7 TION AUTHORITY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (GENERAL) FUND; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE WATER POLLUTION 8 CONTROL FUND TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION (BASIN) FUND FOR FISCAL 9 YEAR 2025; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE DEPARTMENT 10 OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (GENERAL) FUND TO THE CONFINED ANIMAL FEEDING 11 OPERATION (CAFO) FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY 12 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 13

SECTION 3. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided

to the Department of Environmental Quality is hereby increased by six (6.00) 2 for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

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SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMEN-TAL QUALITY (GENERAL) FUND. There is hereby reappropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality any unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality in the Administration and Support Services Program from the Department of Environmental Quality (General) Fund for the electronic data management system for fiscal year 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 from the Department of Environmental Quality (General) Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to the electronic data management system for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein.

SECTION 5. CASH TRANSFER FOR WASTE REMEDIATION. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$1,500,000 from the Water Pollution Control Fund to the Environmental Remediation (Basin) Fund on July 1, 2024, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, to be used for Superfund cleanup projects in the Coeur d'Alene Basin.

SECTION 6. CASH TRANSFER FOR CONFINED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION (CAFO) FUND FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY GENERAL FUND. Of the amount appropriated in Section 1 of this act, there is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$2,000,000 from the Department of Environmental Quality (General) Fund to the Confined Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) Fund on July 1, 2024, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
