5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 7, Title 34, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 34-731, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 34-731. PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY. (1) In years in which a president of the United States is to be nominated and elected, a presidential preference primary shall be held at which voters may express their preferred choice of candidate for a political party for president. The presidential preference primary shall be held in conjunction with primary elections held pursuant to section 34-102, Idaho Code.
- (2) On the tenth Wednesday preceding the primary election, the secretary of state shall contact each national political party to identify the names of any candidates currently recognized as the respective party's candidates for president of the United States. The secretary of state shall certify the list of candidates to the county clerks by the tenth Friday preceding the primary election.
- (3) Upon completion of the state canvas for the presidential preference primary, the secretary of state shall notify the state chair of each political party of the results. A political party may use the results for candidate nomination at its national convention, and nothing in this chapter shall be construed as mandating a political party adopt the results of the presidential preference primary.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
