RELATING TO JUDICIAL COMPENSATION; AMENDING SECTION 59-502, IDAHO CODE, TO 2 REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING SALARIES OF JUDGES AND TO PROVIDE FOR COM-3 PENSATION ESTABLISHED BY THE CITIZENS' COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL COMPEN-4 5 SATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 5, TITLE 59, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 59-502A, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING THE 6 CITIZENS' COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL COMPENSATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 5, TI-7 TLE 59, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 59-502B, IDAHO CODE, 8 TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING JUDICIAL COMPENSATION AS DETERMINED 9 BY THE CITIZENS' COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL COMPENSATION; AND DECLARING AN 10 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 11

12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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13 SECTION 1. That Section 59-502, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 14 amended to read as follows:

59-502. SALARIES OF JUDGES. (1) Commencing on July 1, 2023, the The 15 salary of the justices of the supreme court shall be one hundred sixty-five 16 thousand two hundred twelve dollars (\$165,212) one hundred eighty-one thou-17 sand seven hundred thirty-three dollars (\$181,733) per annum. Commencing on 18 July 1, 2026, the salary of the justices of the supreme court shall be one 19 hundred ninety thousand eight hundred twenty dollars (\$190,820) per annum. 20 Commencing on July 1, 2027, the salary of the justices of the supreme court 21 22 shall be two hundred thousand three hundred sixty-one dollars (\$200,361) per 23 annum. Commencing on July 1, 2028, the salary of the justices of the supreme court shall be two hundred ten thousand three hundred seventy-nine dollars 24 (\$210,379) per annum. 25

(2) Commencing on July 1, 2023, judges <u>Judges</u> of the court of appeals shall receive an annual salary in an amount of eight thousand dollars
 (\$8,000) less than equal to ninety-five percent (95%) of the annual salary of a supreme court justice.

30 (3) Commencing on July 1, 2017, district <u>District</u> judges shall receive
 31 an annual salary in an amount of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) less than
 32 equal to ninety percent (90%) of the annual salary of a judge of the court of
 33 appeals supreme court justice.

(4) Commencing on July 1, 2023, magistrate <u>Magistrate</u> judges shall re ceive an annual salary in an amount of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000) less
 than equal to eighty-five percent (85%) of the annual salary of a district
 judge supreme court justice.

(5) Commencing on December 1, 2028, justices and judges shall receive
 compensation in accordance with rates established by the citizens' commit tee on judicial compensation authorized in sections 59-502A and 59-502B,
 Idaho Code.

(5) (6) Salaries shall be paid on regular pay periods not less fre-1 2 quently than monthly as determined by order of the supreme court as due out of the state treasury, but no justice of the supreme court or judge of the 3 district court or magistrate shall be paid his salary, or any part thereof, 4 unless he shall first take and subscribe an oath that there is not in his 5 hands any matter in controversy not decided by him, which that has been fi-6 nally submitted for his consideration and determination thirty (30) days 7 prior to his taking and subscribing said oath. 8

9 SECTION 2. That Chapter 5, Title 59, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des 11 ignated as Section 59-502A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

59-502A. 12 CITIZENS' COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL COMPENSATION -- MEMBERS --APPOINTMENT -- TERMS -- ELECTION OF CHAIR. (1) There is hereby established 13 the citizens' committee on judicial compensation, to consist of three (3) 14 members appointed by the governor and three (3) members appointed by the leg-15 16 islature with such legislative appointments determined by agreement of the president pro tempore of the senate and the speaker of the house of repre-17 sentatives. No member of the committee shall be appointed before the first 18 Monday of January 2027. Members of the committee shall be residents of the 19 state of Idaho and shall be appointed from the public and without regard to 20 21 political affiliation. No person may be appointed to the committee who is an official or employee of the state of Idaho or any department, agency, or po-22 litical subdivision thereof or who is an official or employee of any county, 23 municipality, or other unit of local government or of any agency or institu-24 tion to which any state funds are appropriated. 25

26 (2) Of the members of the committee first to be appointed, one (1) appointee each of the governor and the legislature shall be appointed for a 27 term of two (2) years, one (1) appointee each of the governor and the legisla-28 ture shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years, and one (1) appointee 29 each of the governor and the legislature shall be appointed for a term of four 30 (4) years, commencing July 1, 2027. Thereafter, all members of the committee 31 shall be appointed for four (4) year terms that commence July 1. Vacancies 32 shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments and for the 33 balance of the unexpired term. The committee shall elect one (1) of its mem-34 35 bers as chair, and members of the committee shall be compensated as provided by section 59-509(b), Idaho Code, which expenses shall be paid from the mon-36 eys appropriated for the operation of the legislature. 37

38 SECTION 3. That Chapter 5, Title 59, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 39 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des 40 ignated as Section 59-502B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

59-502B. JUDICIAL COMPENSATION. (1) Commencing July 1, 2029, no justice or judge of the state of Idaho shall receive any compensation for judicial service, except as established pursuant to this section.

(2) The citizens' committee on judicial compensation shall, on or before November 30, 2028, establish the rates of compensation for judicial
service by justices and judges of the state of Idaho during a two (2) year
period commencing on July 1, 2029. The compensation so established shall, on

or before December 1, 2028, be filed with the secretary of state and the state controller. The rates so established shall be the rates applicable for such two (2) year period specified unless prior to the twenty-fifth legislative day of the first regular session of the seventieth Idaho legislature, by concurrent resolution, the legislature rejects such rates of compensation and declares the same to be inoperative.

(3) Thereafter, the committee shall, on or before the last day of Novem-7 ber of each even-numbered year, establish the rates of compensation for ju-8 dicial service by justices and judges of the state of Idaho during the two (2) 9 year period commencing on the first day of July of the next year. The compen-10 sation so established shall, on or before the first day of December of each 11 even-numbered year, be filed with the secretary of state and the state con-12 troller. The rates so established shall be the rates applicable for the two 13 (2) year period specified unless prior to the twenty-fifth legislative day 14 of the next regular biennial legislative session, by concurrent resolution, 15 16 the legislature rejects such rates of compensation and declares the same to be inoperative. 17

(4) In the event the legislature rejects rates of compensation pursuant
 to this section, the rates of compensation shall remain at the then current
 amounts until the committee again establishes rates of compensation pur suant to this section.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 July 1, 2024.
