Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 3, Title 58, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 58-304B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

58-304B. LEASES. It is the duty of the state board of land commissioners to provide for the location, protection, sale, or rental of state endowment trust lands granted to or acquired by the state in a manner that will secure the maximum long term financial return. In regard to leases, each lease shall include terms and conditions that ensure the sustainable management and stewardship of the leased lands appropriate for the type of use. In some instances, a bond secured from the lessee may be required to ensure the reclamation and restoration of the leased lands upon the expiration or cancelation of the lease. The Idaho department of lands may promulgate rules, subject to legislative approval, for leasing activities that may come before the board or department for consideration.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
