7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW CHAPTER, to be known and designated as Chapter 89, Title 18, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

CHAPTER 89 11 ADVERTISING ILLEGAL PRODUCTS AND SERVICES 12

18-8901. ADVERTISING ILLEGAL PRODUCTS AND SERVICES PROHIBITED. No person that provides marijuana products or abortion products or services that are in violation of Idaho law shall advertise such products, services, or related branding or images on any billboard, sign, newspaper, magazine, pamphlet, or other printed material located or distributed in the state of Idaho or in any mail delivered to an address in the state of Idaho. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
