RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE; AP-2 PROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE 3 FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REDUCING 4 THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE FOR THE PUB-5 LIC HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; REDUCING THE NUMBER 6 OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; REQUIRING NOTIFICATION 7 TO THE LEGISLATURE OF CERTAIN FEDERAL GRANTS; ALLOCATING FUNDING FOR 8 SMOKING CESSATION; DIRECTING USE OF THE STATE OPIOID RESPONSE GRANT; 9 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE 10 FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; REDUCING 11 THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE FOR THE PUBLIC 12 HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; AND DECLARING AN EMER-13 14 GENCY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.

15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Public Health Services Division the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025:

SECTION 3. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Public Health Services Division is hereby reduced by two and five-tenths (2.50) for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

32 SECTION 4. NOTIFICATION OF FEDERAL GRANTS. In addition to the require-33 ments in Section 67-3512 and 67-1917, Idaho Code, the Department of Health 34 and Welfare shall notify the chairmen of the health and welfare committees in 35 both the senate and house of representatives prior to applying or reapplying 36 for any federal grant. Such notification shall include but is not limited to 37 the grant type, the CFDA and DUNSF numbers, the title of the grant, the grant 38 start date, the grant end date, and a brief description of the grant, including the source and long-term impact. This information shall also be sent to the cochairs of the joint finance-appropriations committee.

SECTION 5. SMOKING CESSATION. Notwithstanding any other provision of 3 law to the contrary, \$1,278,900 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund shall 4 be distributed to the public health districts for the purpose of prevention 5 and cessation programs for tobacco, vape, and other substances as funds 6 allow. The Department of Health and Welfare shall transfer the funds on 7 July 1, 2024, or as soon thereafter as practicable. These moneys shall be 8 distributed to each district based on the approved formula of the board 9 of trustees of the Idaho district boards of health as provided in Section 10 39-411(6), Idaho Code. 11

SECTION 6. DIRECTING USE OF THE STATE OPIOID RESPONSE GRANT. Funds
available for naloxone shall be available only to first responders for dis tribution in the State of Idaho.

SECTION 7. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 209, Laws of 2023, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Public Health Services Division the following amounts for the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:
