SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 114

BY JUDICIARY AND RULES COMMITTEE

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND MAKING A FORMAL APPLICATION TO CON-
3 GRESS TO CALL A CONVENTION LIMITED TO PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CON-
4 STITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES TO SET A LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF TERMS THAT
5 A PERSON MAY BE ELECTED AS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRE-
6 SENTATIVES AND TO SET A LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF TERMS THAT A PERSON MAY BE
7 ELECTED AS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE.

8 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 WHEREAS, Article V of the Constitution of the United States mandates
10 that upon the "Application of the Legislatures of two thirds of the several
11 States" Congress shall "call a Convention for proposing Amendments"; and

12 WHEREAS, the Legislature deems an amendment to the Constitution of the
13 United States setting a limit on the number of terms that a person may be
14 elected as a member of the United States House of Representatives and setting
15 a limit on the number of terms that a person may be elected as a member of the
16 United States Senate is necessary for the good of the American people.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
18 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-
19 resentatives concurring therein, that the Legislature of the State of Idaho
20 hereby makes an application to Congress, as provided by Article V of the Con-
21 stitution of the United States, to call a convention limited to proposing an
22 amendment to the Constitution of the United States to set a limit on the num-
23 ber of terms that a person may be elected as a member of the United States
24 House of Representatives and to set a limit on the number of terms that a per-
25 son may be elected as a member of the United States Senate.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State is hereby directed
27 to transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary of the
28 Senate of the United States; to the Speaker, Clerk, and Judiciary Commit-
29 tee Chairman of the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United
30 States; to Idaho's congressional delegation; and to the presiding officers
31 of each of the legislative houses in the several states requesting their co-
32 operation.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application shall be considered as cov-
34 ering the same subject matter as the applications from other states to Con-
35 gress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of terms that a person
36 may be elected to the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United
37 States and the Senate of the United States and that this application shall be
38 aggregated with same for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states
39 necessary to require Congress to call a limited convention on this subject,
40 but shall not be aggregated with any other applications on any other subject.

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application constitutes a continuing
42 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United

1 States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds of the several states
2 have made applications on the same subject.
