 TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE TRANSPORTATION AND DEFENSE COM MITTEE WITH AN EXCEPTION.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, the Legislature must 8 approve pending administrative rules by adoption of a concurrent resolu-9 tion; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, any 11 pending rule that is not approved by adoption of a concurrent resolution 12 shall expire upon adjournment sine die of the legislative session during 13 which the agency submits the pending rule to the Legislature for review; and

14 WHEREAS, the Senate Transportation Committee and the House Transporta15 tion and Defense Committee reviewed pending rules adopted by the Idaho State
16 Police and the Idaho Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that rules of the Idaho State Police, the Motor Carrier Rules, are not consistent with legislative intent because it is a critical exemption for motor carriers that needs to remain in place; and

21 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to 22 adopt this resolution.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular 24 Session of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that the following pending rules 25 adopted by the Idaho Transportation Department, pursuant to the Administra-26 tive Procedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative 27 Rules Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2024 legislative 28 session and reviewed by the Senate Transportation Committee and the House 29 Transportation and Defense Committee, be, and the same are hereby approved: 30
