A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING PENDING RULES OF THE DI VISION OF OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF
INSURANCE REVIEWED BY THE SENATE COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMIT TEE, WITH AN EXCEPTION.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, the Legislature must 8 approve pending administrative rules by adoption of a concurrent resolu-9 tion; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, any 11 pending rule that is not approved by adoption of a concurrent resolution 12 shall expire upon adjournment sine die of the legislative session during 13 which the agency submits the pending rule to the Legislature for review; and

14 WHEREAS, the Senate Commerce and Human Resources Committee reviewed 15 pending rules adopted by the Division of Occupational and Professional Li-16 censes and the Department of Insurance; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the Department of Insurance, The Managed Care Reform Act Rule, are not consistent with legislative intent; and

20 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to 21 adopt this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-22 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-23 resentatives concurring therein, that the following pending rules adopted 24 by the Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses, Rules of the Pub-25 lic Works Contractors License Board, and the Department of Insurance, The 26 Managed Care Reform Act Rule, pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act 27 and submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules Coordinator to 28 the Legislature for review during the 2024 legislative session and reviewed 29 by the Senate Commerce and Human Resources Committee, be, and the same are 30 hereby approved, with the exception of IDAPA 18.04.04, The Managed Care Re-31 form Act Rule, Docket No. 18-0404-2301, Section 011., Subsection 03., only, 32 that is rejected and not approved, and thereby pursuant to Section 67-5291, 33 34 Idaho Code, shall expire upon adjournment sine die of the legislative session and be null, void, and of no force and effect. 35
