Chairman Mendive announced that the Securities Exchange Commission (SEC) denied the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) request for Nature Asset Companies

(NAC's).

reviews there will be refresher training to clear up any confusion about the process.

RS 30867: Rep. Petzke, District 21, presented RS 30867 and briefly explained the Dept. of

Fish and Game currently uses collars to manage game populations. Some hunters have discovered that this data, which includes locations and dates, is available to the public through the record request process. Restrictions already exist in the use of public records requests for hunting endangered species but all species are not included in that protection. This solution was arrived at by gaining input from several different sources, which include sportsman groups, agriculture groups,

and the Idaho Dept. of Fish and Game.

RS 30837: Rep. Garner, District 28, presented **RS 30837** saying the proposed legislation

deals with the Soil and Conservation Districts, clarifying how to decrease board members, how vacancies should be filled, and making some technical corrections.

RS: 30790: Rep. Nelson, District 26, presented RS 30790 saying the proposed legislation is a

Dept. of Water Resources bill intended to clean up code and removing discussion
