**Chairman Mendive** called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Galaviz** made a motion to accept the January 15, 2024 and the January 17, 2024 meeting minutes. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 30795:** **Rep. Manwaring** presented **RS 30795** which he said would bring Idaho into compliance with the National Flood Plain requirements.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Blanksma** made a motion to introduce **RS 30795**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**Chairman Mendive** prepared the Committee for Thursday's Administrative Rules review.

**Chairman Mendive** turned the gavel over to **Vice Chairman Shepherd**.

**DOCKET NO. 24-3501-2301:** **John Price**, Bureau Chief at the Dept. of Occupational and Professional Licenses (DOPL) presented **Docket No. 24-3501-2301** to the Committee. Mr. Price explained there are four alterations to the existing rules. He assured the committee that all the required public meetings have been held, input from perspective land owners has been sought, and the affected agencies have been consulted.

Committee members were unable to access the administrative rules electronically. **Vice Chairman Shepherd** put the committee at ease at 1:36 p.m.

**Vice Chairman Shepherd** called the meeting back to order at 1:40 p.m.

Bureau Chief, **John Price**, continued presenting **Docket No. 24-3501-2301**. The changes to **Docket No. 24-3501-2301** involve some language changes associated with counting allocated tags, and changes in outfitter access to the Clark Fork River, Priest River sections, and Hayden Lake.
