MENTAL HEALTHCARE

PROBLEM

100% of counties have a mental health care shortage.*

SOLUTION

U of I Doctor in Clinical Psychology (PsyD) graduates will treat addiction disorders and address suicide prevention.

OUTCOMES

10-15 graduates a year will treat Idahoans with mental health issues such as substance abuse, depression and suicidal thoughts.

PRIMARY CARE

PROBLEM

98% of state has a primary care workforce shortage.*

SOLUTION

Physican assistant (PA) or nursing graduates will serve our neighbors with urgent care, and family and emergency medicine.

OUTCOMES

15-20 graduates a year will provide skilled medical care, improve health outcomes, and save lives.

FUNDING REQUEST: \$2,139,200

CYBERSECURITY

PROBLEM

Critical systems that serve our state and industry are at risk from cyberattacks.

SOLUTION


- Increase the number of graduates with cybersecurity degrees to help fight cyberterrorism
