H 601: **Chairman Skaug** called the meeting to order at 1:30pm.

Rep. Dixon (1) presented **H 601** regarding security teams.

Committee inquired regarding firearm training, insurance expense, and current examples of civil liability incidents.

Dianna David, Karen Hansen, and Julianne Donnelly Tzul, ACLU of Idaho, testified in opposition.

Committee inquired regarding clarification of application to faith-based organizations, questionable validity of connections of faith-based organizations to foreign terrorist entities, criminal charges compared to domestic terrorism language, definition of terrorism, and positive impact to parents at school board meetings.
