Chairman Skaug called the meeting to order at 1:30pm.

H 601: Rep. Dixon (1) presented H 601 regarding security teams.

Committee inquired regarding firearm training, insurance expense, and current

examples of civil liability incidents.

MOTION: Rep. Scott made a motion to send H 601 to the floor with a DO PASS

recommendation.

ROLL CALL VOTE ON MOTION: Chairman Skaug stated he was in doubt regarding the voice vote and called for a roll call vote on the motion. Motion carried by a vote of 12 AYE, 4 NAY and 2 Absent/Excused. Garner, Gannon, Mathias, Achilles. Reps. Cannon and Erickson were absent/excused. Rep. Dixon (1)

H 623: Rep. Pickett presented H 623 regarding domestic terrorism.

Maria Brown, Jenny Shurtliff, Julie Lynde, Idaho Family Policy Center, Lydon

Crane, and Jennie Bateman, testified in support.

Dianna David, Karen Hansen, and **Julianne Donnelly Tzul**, ACLU of Idaho, testified **in opposition**.

Committee inquired regarding clarification of application to faith-based organizations, questionable validity of connections of faith-based organizations to foreign terrorist entities, criminal charges compared to domestic terrorism language, definition of terrorism, and positive impact to parents at school board meetings.

recommendation.

Rep. Mathias made a substitute motion to HOLD H 623 in committee.

Skaug, Scott, Ehardt, Young, Alfieri, Allgood, Gallagher, Handy, Lambert. Reps. Cannon and Erickson were

absent/excused.
