


Attachment 1 U.S. Debt-to-Income Ratio Loren Enns 3-1-24

Due to the massive size of our debt, interest is now the second largest item in the Federal budget.

- In FY2023, we paid a record \$882 billion to service the debt. That's 20% of all Federal revenue blown on interest!
- That will soon spike to 25% as Congress borrows \$2 trillion more each year, pushing us ever closer to disaster as interest chokes the Federal budget.


