Chair Yamamoto called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

RS 31715: Rep. Furniss presented **RS 31715**, proposed legislation regarding the public education facilities fund. He said this bill would create a fund in the State Treasury to support education facilities. He discussed the application process and the facilities fund formula. Money in the fund would be distributed as a needs-based grant to finance construction, remodel, and maintenance of school facilities.

Rep. Galaviz spoke about school facilities in Salmon, Idaho and thirteen failed bond attempts. She addressed primary safety concerns and constitutional responsibility. She said this grant process would help close bonding gaps to provide a safe learning environment.
