BY REVENUE AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AN ACT

RELATING TO SALES TAX DISTRIBUTION; AMENDING SECTION 63-3638, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN SALES TAX REVENUES TO THE TRANSPORTATION EXPANSION AND CONGESTION MITIGATION FUND AND TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT FOR HIGHWAY PROJECTS; AMENDING SECTION 40-720, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING MONEYS APPORTIONED TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
