RELATING TO TAXATION; AMENDING SECTION 63-3004, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A DEFINITION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.

#### HOUSE BILL NO. 4

##### BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

##### AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES AND CYBERSECURITY; AMENDING SECTION 67-827A, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING POWERS AND DUTIES, TO REQUIRE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CYBERSECURITY BEST PRACTICES, TO REQUIRE CERTAIN USE OF MULTIFACTOR IDENTIFICATION, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AMENDING SECTION 67-831, IDAHO CODE, TO DEFINE A TERM AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AMENDING CHAPTER 23, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-2362, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF MULTIFACTOR IDENTIFICATION BY THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH, JUDICIAL BRANCH, AND ELECTED CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

[H 3](#) and [H 4](#) were introduced, read the first time by title, and referred to the Judiciary, Rules, and Administration Committee for printing.
