#### CERTIFICATE OF APPOINTMENT

**KNOW ALL PEOPLE,** by these present, that pursuant to the provisions of Section 59-904A, <u>Idaho Code</u>, the District 1 Legislative Committee of the Republican Party has submitted a list of three names for consideration in filling a vacancy in the Idaho State House of Representatives.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRAD LITTLE,** Governor of the State of Idaho, by virtue of the authority vested in me do hereby appoint CORNEL RASOR of Sagle, Idaho, to the office of State Representative, District 1, Seat B, for a term commencing September 17, 2024, and continuing until the next general election when the term of office expires.

At this time, Mr. Monks and Ms. Rubel escorted Mr. Moyle to the podium where the oath of office was administered to him by Representative Crane(13).

At this time, Speaker Moyle took the Chair.

Mr. Monks moved that the House adopt as Rules for the First and Second Sessions of the Sixty-eighth Legislature, the Rules as adopted by the Sixty-seventh Legislature. Seconded by Ms. Rubel.

Whereupon the Speaker declared by voice vote that a majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, the motion carried and the Rules were adopted.

There being no objection, the House advanced to the Thirteenth Order of Business.
