## HOUSE BILL NO. 110

### BY HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE

#### AN ACT

RELATING TO PRACTICE AUTHORITY PROTECTION; AMENDING CHAPTER 94, TITLE 67,
IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-9417, IDAHO CODE, TO PRO VIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE SHALL NOT PROHIBIT LI CENSED OR REGISTERED HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FROM PROVIDING SERVICES COV ERED BY THE STATE MEDICAID PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PRO VIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 94, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des 11 ignated as Section 67-9417, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 67-9417. PRACTICE AUTHORITY PROTECTION. If a health care service is 13 covered by state law in the medicaid program, the state department of health 14 and welfare shall not prohibit any state licensed or registered health care 15 provider from providing the service within the provider's state-authorized 16 practice from the licensing authority unless:

17 (1) State law or regulation expressly excludes a certain health care18 provider type from providing the service to medicaid beneficiaries; or

19 (2) The provider fails to enter into a written provider agreement with20 the medicaid program.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
