

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS32099C1 / H0223

Amending the Code regarding Legislative Review of Administrative Rules to require concurrent resolution when rejecting an existing (final) rule, setting the termination time of June 30th of the year the rule is rejected. Additionally, allows the expiration of temporary, or fee and non-fee rules to be stated in the concurrent resolution as an alternative to sine die.

FISCAL NOTE

There are no costs anticipated as the various state agencies already work through agency rules pursuant to the governor's ZBR order. Therefore this legislation causes no additional expenditure of funds at the state or local level of government, nor does it cause an increase or decrease in revenue for state or local government.
