The Joint Printing Committee recommends the continued endorsement of limiting the printing of the Idaho Session Laws to a maximum of 90 copies given the accessibility and decrease in expenditures associated with online access. Provided if, there is a significant decrease in orders submitted, that the amount of copies decrease in order to ensure cost saving measures are considered. The 2024 publishing price was \$2,000 in legislative expenditures.

The Joint Printing Committee also requests that the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives be allotted the time to continue to process, review, and upload historic Session Law volumes and Journals to the legislative website during the next two legislative interims.
