SENATE BILL NO. 1010

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO HEALTH; AMENDING TITLE 39, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW
2 CHAPTER 73, TITLE 39, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE WORLD HEALTH OR-
3 GANIZATION SHALL HAVE NO JURISDICTION IN THE STATE OF IDAHO; AND DECLAR-
4 ING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Title 39, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended
8 by the addition thereto of a NEW CHAPTER, to be known and designated as Chap-
9 ter 73, Title 39, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

10 CHAPTER 73

11 MISCELLANEOUS HEALTH PROVISIONS

12 39-7301. WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION JURISDICTION. The world health
13 organization, a specialized agency governed by the world health assembly,
14 shall have no jurisdiction or control over the government of the state of
15 Idaho or any agency, branch, department, or function organized under the
16 government of the state of Idaho with respect to all matters related to,
17 connected to, or associated with public health within the state of Idaho.
18 The citizens of Idaho shall not be subject to the terms, conditions, rules,
19 or regulations promulgated by the world health organization or arising from
20 any agreement, directive, initiative, or program instituted by agreement
21 between the federal government and the world health organization.

22 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
24 July 1, 2025.
