A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE  
3 INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE RULES UNDER THE  
4 WORKER'S COMPENSATION LAW.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-  
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the  
11 Industrial Commission relating to Administrative Rules Under the Worker's  
12 Compensation Law are not consistent with legislative intent and should be  
13 rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular  
15 Session of the Sixty-eighth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House  
16 of Representatives concurring therein, that final rule contained in IDAPA  
17 17.01.01, Section 305., Subsection 01.a., relating to Administrative Rules  
18 Under the Worker's Compensation Law, Rules of the Industrial Commission,  
19 only, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void, and of no  
20 force and effect as of July 1, 2025.
