A SENATE RESOLUTION

1 STATING FINDINGS OF THE SENATE AND PROVIDING THAT ALL TEMPORARY AND PEND-  
2 ING RULES OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL  
3 REHABILITATION HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE SENATE EDUCATION  
4 COMMITTEE, WITH EXCEPTIONS.

6 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, standing committees  
8 of the Legislature shall review any temporary or pending rule that is ger-  
9 mane to its committee and has been published in the Idaho Administrative Bul-  
10 letin; and

11 WHEREAS, the Senate Education Committee reviewed temporary and pending  
12 rules adopted by the State Board of Education and the Division of Vocational  
13 Rehabilitation.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Senate, assembled  
15 in the First Regular Session of the Sixty-eighth Idaho Legislature, that all  
16 temporary and pending rules adopted by the State Board of Education and the  
17 Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, pursuant to the Administrative Pro-  
18 cedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules Co-  
19 ordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2025 legislative session  
20 have been reviewed and approved by the Senate Education Committee with the  
21 following exceptions that were not approved:

22 (1) IDAPA 08.02.03, State Board of Education, Rules Governing Thor-  
23 oughness, Docket No. 08-0203-2401, Grade 4 Social Studies and Grade  
24 6-12 U.S. History 1 of the Idaho Content Standards, incorporated by ref-  
25 erence under Section 004., Subsection 01.g., and Section 105., Subsec-  
26 tion 01.d., only;

27 (2) IDAPA 08.01.11, State Board of Education, Registration of Post-  
28 secondary Educational Institutions and Proprietary Schools, Docket No.  
29 08-0111-2401, the entire docket;

30 (3) IDAPA 08.02.02, State Board of Education, Rules Governing Unifor-  
31 mity, Docket No. 08-0202-2401, the entire docket; and

32 (4) IDAPA 08.02.03, State Board of Education, Rules Governing Thor-  
33 oughness, Docket No. 08-0203-2402, the entire docket.
