Chairman Skaug called the meeting to order at 1:36pm.
RS 31861: **Rep. Erickson** presented **RS 31861** regarding the Idaho State Board of Education goal of preventing targeted violence through use of behavioral threat assessment teams.
Committee inquired regarding the assessment process, school district implementation, liability and litigation, proof of negligence, profiling clarity, fiscal impact of training, and the priority of saving lives.
MOTION: **Rep. Scott** made a motion to introduce **RS 31861. Motion carried by voice vote.**
Chairman Skaug turned the gavel over to **Vice Chairman Alfieri.**
RS 31834: **Chairman Skaug** presented **RS 31834** regarding expansion of the Attorney General's prosecutorial jurisdiction to include elected city officials.
MOTION: **Rep. Handy** made a motion to introduce **RS 31834. Motion carried by voice vote.**
RS 31835: **Chairman Skaug** presented **RS 31835** regarding amending current statute by the addition of a mandatory minimum fine for first time convictions of marijuana possession of three ounces, or less, of net weight. The minimum fine would not apply to juveniles.
Committee inquired regarding the origin of the language "not less than", and requested clarification of the exemption for juveniles.
MOTION: **Rep. Garner** made a motion to introduce **RS 31835. Motion carried by voice vote.**
Vice Chairman Alfieri turned the gavel over to **Chairman Skaug.**
ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 2:00pm.
