**Chairman Crane (13)** called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Achilles** made a motion to approve the minutes of January 8, 2025. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 31885:** **Rep. Raybould** presented **RS 31885** which requires all state agencies to implement and use multifactor authentication to increase cybersecurity on state devices and when accessing state resources. It also clarifies the role of the Office of Information Technology when it relates to issues of information security, risk, identification/mitigation, education/training, and state agency cybersecurity best practices.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Mickelsen** made a motion to introduce **RS 31885**.  
Committee member raised a question around sources queried regarding financial resource impact.

**VOTE ON  
MOTION:** **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**HCR 2:** **Rep. Ehardt** presented **HCR 2** in bringing a resolution to honor and commend the Boise State University Woman's Volleyball team for its courage and commitment in standing strongly for the integrity of woman's sports by keeping women's sports for woman only in alignment with Idaho's 'Fairness in Woman's Sports Act' and **Governor Little's** executive order.  
**Riley Gains**, Woman's sports activist, spoke **in support** of the Resolution. Committee members raised questions around her experience.  
**Marchi Smith**, Former NCAA Captain, **Edward Clark**, Idaho Family Policy Center, and **April Chainey**, spoke **in support** of the Resolution.  
**Nikson Matthews**, spoke **in opposition** of the Resolution. Committee members raised questions around marginalized gender, fair treatment/discrimination, and communications with the transgender community.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Crane (12)** made a motion to send **HCR 2** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation.  
**Rep. Green and Rep. Achilles** spoke **in opposition** of the motion.

**VOTE ON  
MOTION:** **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Green and Rep. Achilles** requested to be recorded as **NAY** on **HCR 2**. **Rep. Ehardt** will sponsor the bill on the floor.

**Chairman Crane (13)** mentioned there will be no committee meetings for the next three Friday sessions.
