Chairman Cannon called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

RS 32013: Speaker Moyle presented RS 32013, an income tax reduction bill. The Speaker

claimed this will be the largest income tax cut in state history by reducing the income tax rate from 5.695% to 5.3%, expanding the income tax exemption on US military pensions, and removing a tax on capital gains for gold and silver. He noted this bill is the first of several bills this session to reduce taxes across the board.

MOTION: Rep. Raybould made a motion to introduce RS 32013.

Rep. Gannon referenced a possible error in the Statement of Purpose, which mentioned only corporate income tax reduction and not individual income tax reduction in the legislation, and asked whether a modified motion to include a

correction would be in order.

Rep. Raybould pointed out the SOP does not carry legislative weight and can be

changed at any time without modifying the motion.

In opposition to the motion, **Rep. Berch** noted his concerns about the lack of fiscal analysis at a broader scale, and wanted further analysis of the bigger picture of the

state's fiscal obligations as to whether the state can afford this tax cut.

Rep. Gannon supported the motion but noted he was concerned this tax cut would

prevent the state from addressing or adding to the grocery tax credit.

VOTE ON MOTION:

Motion carried by voice vote.

RS 32008: Rep. Weber presented RS 32008, which is the formal resolution approving the

administrative rules the Committee heard earlier in the week.

MOTION: Rep. Raybould made a motion to send RS 32008 to the Second Reading Calendar

with a **DO PASS** recommendation.

Chairman Cannon put the committee at ease at 9:12 AM.

Chairman Cannon resumed the meeting at 9:13 AM.

MOTION WITHDRAWN:

Rep. Raybould asked for Unanimous Consent to withdraw her motion. There

being no objection, the motion was withdrawn.

MOTION: Rep. Raybould made a motion to introduce RS 32008 and recommend it be sent to

the Second Reading Calendar with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried

by voice vote. Rep. Weber will sponsor the resolution on the floor.

ADJOURN:	There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 9:15 AM.
