**MOTION:** **Chairman Skaug** called the meeting to order at 1:29pm.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Mathias** made a motion to approve the January 29, 2025 meeting minutes. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**Chairman Skaug** turned the gavel over to **Vice Chairman Alfieri**.

**RS 31863:** **Chairman Skaug** presented **RS 31863** regarding judicial salaries and the indexing with Supreme Court Justices' salaries, set in Idaho Code, to avoid salary compression between the four types of judgeships.

Committee inquired regarding the process of changing pay increase amounts.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Rubel** made a motion to introduce **RS 31863**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**Vice Chairman Alfieri** turned the gavel over to **Chairman Skaug**.

**RS 32130:** **Rep. Rubel** presented **RS 32130** regarding removal of the requirement that all fines and fees be paid in order for record sealing eligibility.

Committee inquired regarding specific examples.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Handy** made a motion to introduce **RS 32130**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 32055:** **Rep. Shirts** presented **RS 32055** regarding expanded search authority for probation and parole officers, on probationers and parolees, to include other law enforcement officers.

Committee inquired regarding search requirements under rule, existence of friction toward proposal, constitutionality of surrendering rights, prevention of undue harassment, electronic device searches, and supervised probation.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Pohanka** made a motion to introduce **RS 32055**.

**SUBSTITUTE  
MOTION:** **Rep. Scott** made a substitute motion to return **RS 32055** to the sponsor. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 32035:** **Rep. Crane (12)** presented **RS 32035** regarding injury resulting from riots.

Committee inquired regarding current penalties for assault.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Gannon** made a motion to introduce **RS 32035**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 32154:** **Rep. Gannon** presented **RS 32154** regarding clear and conspicuous disclosure of artificial intelligence used to generate voices.

Committee inquired regarding the existence of a working group.

- MOTION:** Rep. Rubel made a motion to introduce **RS 32154**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**  
**Chairman Skaug** turned the gavel over to **Vice Chairman Alfieri**.
- H 37:** **Chairman Skaug** presented **H 37** regarding changing use of firing squad to the primary method of execution, and lethal injection to the secondary method.  
**Daniel Murphy, LaMont Anderson**, Deputy Attorney General, and **Anthony Oxsen** testified **in support**.  
**Dianna David, David Powell**, Idahoans Against the Death Penalty, **Kylie Castellaw**, and **Kate Lopez** testified **in opposition**.  
Committee inquired regarding mental health of executioners, execution protocol, and cost.
- MOTION:** Rep. Ehardt made a motion to send **H 37** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation.
- ROLL CALL VOTE ON MOTION:** **Chairman Skaug** requested a roll call vote. **Motion carried by a vote of 12 AYE, 2 NAY, 1 Absent/Excused. Voting in favor** of the motion: **Reps. Alfieri, Scott, Ehardt, Erickson, Garner, Handy, Hawkins, Hill, Hostetler, Pohanka, Shirts, Skaug**. **Voting in opposition** to the motion: **Reps. Gannon, Mathias**. **Rep. Rubel** was **Absent/Excused**. **Rep. Skaug** will sponsor the bill on the floor.  
**Vice Chairman Alfieri** turned the gavel over to **Chairman Skaug**.
- H 36:** **Rep. Pohanka** and **Brian Nickels**, Office of Administrative Hearings, presented **H 36** regarding parameters for requests, issuance, service, and enforcement of subpoenas.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Gannon** made a motion to send **H 36** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Pohanka** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 2:44pm.
