- H 380:** **Chairman Skaug** presented **H 380** regarding imposition of the death penalty for a person convicted of certain sexual crimes against children when certain statutory aggravating circumstances are proved.
- Mark Eaton, Holly Rebholtz**, Idaho Prosecuting Attorney's Association, **John Dinger**, Idaho Prosecuting Attorney's Association, **Whitne Strain, Daniel Murphy**, and **Anthony Oxsen**, testified **in support.**
- Committee inquired regarding the definition of lewd conduct, application to statutory rape, plea bargaining, rehabilitation of perpetrators, repeat offenders, effectiveness of legislation, and death penalty application.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Hawkins** made a motion to send **H 380** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Skaug** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- Vice Chairman Alfieri** turned the gavel over to **Chairman Skaug.**
- S 1099:** **Sen. Bernt** presented **S 1099** regarding vehicular manslaughter.
- Darren Hurst**, Meridian Police Department, and **Robby Bleazard**, Idaho Prosecuting Attorney Association, testified **in support.**
- Committee inquired regarding impact of lowering blood alcohol content minimums for DUI, and exacerbation by drugs.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Hill** made a motion to send **S 1099** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Shirts** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
