



Idaho Legislature Joint Millennium Fund Committee

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PRESS RELEASE

The Joint Millennium Fund Committee is accepting grant proposals for Millennium Income Fund dollars for state Fiscal Year 2028 (July 1, 2027 – June 30, 2028).

The Idaho Millennium Fund was established by the Legislature in 2000 as the repository of all funds received by the State of Idaho under the tobacco Master Settlement Agreement reached between participating states and tobacco product manufacturers. Each fiscal year, five percent of the fund's fair market value is made available for legislative appropriation. The Joint Millennium Fund Committee, made up of five senators and five representatives, is charged with reviewing grant applications and providing a funding recommendation to the Legislature.

Applications will be considered for programs that target prevention, cessation, and treatment related to tobacco, vape, alcohol, illegal substances, and other substances that may be abused beyond the intended uses and for the overall safety and well-being of Idaho youth. Funding is prioritized first to programs that benefit Idahoans under 18 years of age and then for adults with higher risk factors for abusing or using various substances.
