HOUSE BILL NO. 492

BY JUDICIARY, RULES AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL; AMENDING SECTION 19-5102, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTAIN PERSON FROM THE IDAHO ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 19-5102, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

19-5102. COUNCIL ESTABLISHED -- CHAIRMAN -- MEMBERS. (1) There is hereby established in the Idaho state police the Idaho peace officer standards and training council. The chairman of the council shall be appointed by the governor and shall be a voting member of the council ~~which~~. The council shall be composed of the following members, and which shall reflect a reasonable geographic balance throughout the state:

- (a) Three (3) city chiefs of police or their designees;
- (b) Three (3) county sheriffs or their designees;
- (c) The director of the Idaho state police or his designee;
- (d) A county prosecuting attorney or his designee;
- (e) The attorney general or his designee;
- (f) The special agent in charge of the Idaho division of the federal bureau of investigation or his designee;
- (g) The director of the department of correction or his designee;
- (h) The director of the fish and game department or his designee;
- (i) The director of the department of juvenile corrections or his designee; and
- (j) A representative from the Idaho association of counties juvenile justice administrators or the Idaho association of counties adult misdemeanor probation administrators association.

~~(j)~~ (2) In addition, there shall be advisory to the council, as ex officio nonvoting members of the council, the executive directors of the Idaho association of counties and association of Idaho cities.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2026.
