

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS33584 / H0872

This bill is a slight modification to Idaho code 34-906 concerning general elections. When the general election ballot contains a constitutional amendment or another issue, current law requires that a page break occur between the ballot and the issue, or that the issue be printed on a separate page from the rest of the ballot. This often causes portions of the ballot to be blank and wastes paper. This bill removes that requirement. This bill will allow the constitutional amendment or issue being considered to begin on the same page or on the back of the same page as the rest of the ballot.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no negative fiscal impact on the General Fund. It will likely result in savings to the cost of printing ballots for the counties.
