A HOUSE RESOLUTION

1 STATING FINDINGS OF THE HOUSE AND PROVIDING THAT ALL TEMPORARY AND PEND-  
2 ING RULES OF THE IDAHO COMMISSION ON AGING, THE IDAHO COMMISSION FOR  
3 THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE,  
4 AND THE DIVISION OF OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSES HAVE BEEN  
5 REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE HOUSE HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE, WITH  
6 EXCEPTIONS.

8 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Idaho:

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, standing committees  
10 of the Legislature shall review any temporary or pending rule that is ger-  
11 mane to its committee and has been published in the Idaho Administrative Bul-  
12 letin; and

13 WHEREAS, the House Health and Welfare Committee reviewed temporary and  
14 pending rules adopted by the Idaho Commission on Aging, the Idaho Commission  
15 for the Blind and Visually Impaired, the Department of Health and Welfare,  
16 and the Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses; and

17 WHEREAS, the House Health and Welfare Committee did not review and  
18 therefore did not approve the following pending rules at the request of the  
19 Department of Health and Welfare, who expressed intent to allow the rules to  
20 expire upon sine die:

21 (1) IDAPA 16.06.03, Department of Health and Welfare, Rules for Daycare  
22 Licensing, Docket No. 16-0603-2501, the entire docket, at the request  
23 of the department; and

24 (2) IDAPA 16.06.12, Department of Health and Welfare, Rules for the  
25 Idaho Child Care Program, Docket No. 16-0612-2501, the entire docket,  
26 at the request of the department.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Represen-  
28 tatives, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-eighth Idaho  
29 Legislature, that all temporary and pending rules adopted by the Idaho Com-  
30 mission on Aging, the Idaho Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired,  
31 the Department of Health and Welfare, and the Division of Occupational and  
32 Professional Licenses, pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act and  
33 submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules Coordinator to  
34 the Legislature for review during the 2026 legislative session have been  
35 reviewed and approved by the House Health and Welfare Committee, with the  
36 following exceptions that were not approved:

37 (1) IDAPA 16.06.03, Department of Health and Welfare, Rules for Daycare  
38 Licensing, Docket No. 16-0603-2501, the entire docket, at the request  
39 of the department;

40 (2) IDAPA 16.06.12, Department of Health and Welfare, Rules for the  
41 Idaho Child Care Program, Docket No. 16-0612-2501, the entire docket,  
42 at the request of the department;

- 1 (3) IDAPA 24.06.01, Division of Occupational and Professional Li-  
2 censes, Rules for the Licensure of Occupational Therapists and Occupa-  
3 tional Therapy Assistants, Docket No. 24-0601-2501, the entire docket;

5 (4) IDAPA 24.13.01, Division of Occupational and Professional Li-  
6 censes, Rules Governing the Physical Therapy Licensure Board, Docket  
7 No. 24-1301-2501, the entire docket.
