

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS32899 / S1244

To ensure that state laws are streamlined, up-to-date, and essential for the citizens of Idaho, while best serving the public health, safety, and welfare, the Legislature approved the Idaho Code Cleanup Act, H14 in the 2025 legislative session. Submitted sections of Idaho Code were reviewed for repeal consideration by the DOGE Task Force on the criteria of obsolete, outdated, and unnecessary.

This bill repeals eight sections Chapter 26, Title 33, Idaho Code that pertain to the regional library systems as these systems have not existed for more than 40 years.
