

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS32907 / S1272

To ensure that state laws are streamlined, up-to-date, and essential for the citizens of Idaho, while best serving the public health, safety, and welfare, the Legislature approved the Idaho Code Cleanup Act, H14 in the 2025 legislative session. Submitted sections of Idaho Code were reviewed for repeal consideration by the DOGE Task Force on the criteria of obsolete, outdated, and unnecessary.

This bill repeals or updates 11 sections of Idaho Code in Title 21, Title 40, and Title 49 pertaining to transportation. Sections include provisions for and repealing specialty license plates, posting notices of traffic regulations regarding horses, mules, and cattle, passageways for stock, and other obsolete or outdated language.

There is no fiscal impact to any local, state, or federal fund with this legislation.
