Weights and Measures

- Inspect devices used in commerce- scales, gas pumps, propane, ect.
- 12 full time personnel, same as 1979
- 2025 inspected 38,380 devices
 - 6% rejection rate with 66% re-checked
 - 1979 – 7,700 devices inspected with same staffing
- Investigate consumer complaints
- Perform calibration tests for standards in metrology lab
