<a href="#"><u>RS 33024</u></a>	This legislation closes a gap in Idaho law by extending existing sex offender residence restrictions to daycares that are zoned, permitted, or approved by a city or county. This changes ensures consistent protections for children without expanding licensing requirements or regulating home daycares.	Sen. Nichols
<a href="#"><u>RS 33058</u></a>	This legislation is an update of current Idaho Code sections that address guardianship and conservatorship for adults and minors.	Sen. Ruchti
<a href="#"><u>S 1226</u></a>	SAMPLE COLLECTIONS - Amends, repeals, and adds to existing law to revise provisions and requirements regarding collection of DNA samples and thumbprint impressions.	Sen. Wintrow
